ZULEKHA HOSPITAL INAUGURATED THE 'HEALTH & RECREATION CLUB' FOR EMPLOYEES





SUCCES STARIES

ZULEKHA HOSPITAL, SHARJAH SUCCESSFULLY TREATS HIGH-RISK CARDIAC EMERGENCY

A 53-year-old, hypertensive UAE resident was successfully treated for a high risk cardiac emergency at Zulekha Hospital, Sharjah by Dr. Mohamed Ahmed Helmy, Consultant Cardiac Surgeon. The condition, Acute Aortic Dissection type A (AADA), is a life-threatening vascular condition which affects three in every 100,000 patients and has a very high mortality rate.

The patient developed severe chest pain and immediately further investigations and a Multislice CT angiography was done to confirm the diagnoses as an acute ascending aortic dissection. The cardiac surgery team transferred him immediately to the ICU (Intensive Care Unit) where instant surgical interference by an expert team of doctors was essential for the success of such a high-risk procedure on the same day of admission.



prolonged ICU stay. After a highly complex and risky procedure, we're pleased to see the patient made a full recovery," he concluded.

Commenting on this case, Dr. Mohamed Ahmed Helmy said, "Prompt diagnosis was the need of the hour as time was scarce. There is a high possibility of several complications with such cases which include bleeding, re-exploration, neurological disorders, renal failures and

CRITICAL HAEMORRHAGE CASE TREATED SUCCESSFULLY IN ZULEKHA HOSPITAL, SHARJAH

Zulekha Hospital, Sharjah; successfully treated a critical combined case after a patient was suffering from an intra-cerebral haemorrhage joined by a clot in the pulmonary artery and bilateral lower limb deep vein thrombosis (DVT). Forty three year old Lopez Mattie Osena was admitted to the hospital after an overwhelming feeling of dizziness followed by right-sided chest pain associated with shortness of breath. Other hospitals had refrained from treating such a high-risk case. That is when Mr. Lopez was referred to Zulekha Hospital.

Upon admission, the medical team at Zulekha Hospital, Sharjah led by Dr. Maged Abulmagd, Consultant ICU, and supported by Dr. Amro Kabakbjy, Interventional Radiologist, they advised urgent tests.



Dr. Maged commented on the case saying: "By embracing the Hospital's multidisciplinary care services, we were able to leverage the necessary skills of world-class vascular surgeons, interventional radiologists and cutting-edge Cath lab facilities. Together we succeeded in treating the highly complex case which resulted in saving the life of Mr. Lopez. The case was not easy due to having to apply blood thinning drugs to clear the clots in a case where the patient had already suffered a severe cerebral haemorrhage."

ZULEKHA HOSPITAL, DUBAI SAVES THE LIFE OF A CHILD WITH CEREBELLAR TUMOURS

Zulekha Hospital, Dubai, swiftly admitted a two year old boy when his parents brought him in as they noticed unusual symptoms including gait imbalance and a squint in his eye. MRI scan revealed a large tumour growing on his brain and the boy then underwent lifesaving surgery to remove the tumour.

Dr. Salim Kanaan, Consultant Neurological Surgery at Zulekha Hospital who reviewed the MRIs, advised the tumour was likely to be growing slowly over the last two years, since the child was born. The boy, Julian, had been unable to walk properly due to compression on the brain (cerebellum) which resulted in 'Gait Ataxia'. Also his head circumference was disproportionate to the size of his body due to build-up of fluid in the brain, known as 'Hydrocephalus'.

Following the diagnosis, the parents understood that surgery for their son

PARALYSED PATIENT STARTS WALKING AGAIN AFTER SURGERY AT ALEXIS MULTISPECIALITY HOSPITAL

An eighteen years old male patient was brought to the emergency of Alexis Multispeciality Hospital with a history of fall from fourth floor with weakness in both lower limbs. Patient was conscious with GCS 15/15; power in upper limbs was 5/5 and in lower limbs 1-2/5 with decreased sensation in both lower limbs and Foley's catheter in situ. Vitals were stable. CT brain and abdomen were normal and MRI spine showed L1 vertebral burst compression fracture with retropulsion causing spinal cord compression and cord contusion. There was extradural hematoma extending up to T8 level and sacrococcygeal fracture with presacral hematoma. After proper counselling and consent, patient was posted for surgery. Decompression of cord and spinal fixation was done with pedicle screws and rods between T11,




with walker after 6 weeks. Foley's catheter was removed. After 3 months patient could walk without support with normal power in lower limbs. - Article by **Dr. Husain Bhati**

T12 and L2, L3 vertebrae with distraction. Patient was postoperatively kept in ICU then shifted to ward. Regular physiotherapy was started. Power in lower limbs gradually started improving and patient started walking

PATIENT SUCCESSFULLY TREATED WITH INTERSTITIAL BRACHYTHERAPY FOR VAULT RECURRENCE

Alexis Multispeciality Hospital successfully performed the first pelvic interstitial implant. A 64 year old lady was diagnosed with carcinoma of endometrium in the year 2017 and underwent total abdominal hysterectomy with bilateral salphingo-oophorectomy in November 2017. She was then kept on follow up as it was an early stage in disease. After a year, she developed 10*12mm nodular recurrent lesion over the vaginal vault, which was biopsy proven adenocarcinoma. She came to Alexis and was treated with external beam radiotherapy to pelvis by image guided IMRT to a dose of 50Gy in 25 fractions over 5 weeks after which pelvic interstitial implant was done under spinal anaesthesia. Total 16 titanium needles were inserted in and around the diseased part using Martinez universal perineal interstitial template (MUPIT) which were retained



in situ for 2.5 days during which time, she received 5 sessions of HDR brachytherapy, twice daily, 6 hours apart to a dose of 4Gy each (for a total dose of 20Gy in 5 fractions, as a boost to gross disease over vault). She responded to the treatment well and then the implant was removed uneventfully. She recovered well and was discharged from the hospital.

The pain of having needles in situ for almost 50 hours was adequately managed by epidural analgesia with the support of anaesthesia team. As per our information, Alexis Multispeciality Hospital is the first hospital to do a pelvic interstitial radiotherapy in Nagpur and Central India.
